

In the upcoming 2018, we hope to work more with you to make JOVS a better platform for surgeons all over the world!



Geographic Distribution of Editorial Board Members




Distribution of Research Field of Board Members







Number of Published Articles (results by year)




With a steady increase, JOVS has published **189** articles in 2017.

Number of Published Surgical Videos (results by year)




Till 2017, JOVS has totally published about **539** surgical videos.


Diverse Types of Article Published in 2017







International Diversity of Corresponding Authors in 2017





In this installment, I propose to demonstrate how the 20th century abstract expressionists Clyfford Still, Barnett Newman, and Mark Rothko might have observed natural elements in a manner similar to the 19th century artists and used them, within the context of their time (in which social and artistic norms, from the time leading up to World War I and extending to the present day, have undergone fragmentation and reconstitution into forms both disjointed and disruptive) to evolve their own unique styles of painting.





